The City of Union City announces the completion of the Union City Safe Routes to School Enhancement of Pedestrian Infrastructure at James Logan High School and Guy Emanuele, Jr. Elementary School Project. The improvements that were installed on Meyers Drive and Decoto Road have brought numerous benefits to the nearby schools and community. The pedestrian safety improvements, including enhanced signage, striping and a midblock rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB) crossing system, have made it safer for students and other pedestrians to navigate the area, reducing the risk of accidents and promoting healthier transportation modes as an alternative to motor vehicles.



These improvements should encourage more parents to consider walking or cycling with their children to school, promoting physical activity and a healthier lifestyle. Additionally, with improved safety measures in place, parents may feel more at ease allowing their children to walk or bike independently, fostering a sense of community, trust, and empowerment.
