



Union City Transit Going Electric!

Union City Transit successfully received a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Low or No Emission Vehicle competitive grant in August 2022. Union City Transit staff awarded the contract for fourteen (14) thirty-five foot (35') low-floor battery electric buses to be delivered in 2024/25.

The fourteen (14) buses will represent seventy-eight percent (78%) of Union City Transit's bus fleet making it possible to provide the cleanest public transit bus option in southern Alameda County.

While these FTA funds will pay for the purchase of the vehicles, your Measure BB funds help fund the operations of these vehicles. Thank you for supporting public transit and thank you for riding Union City Transit!
