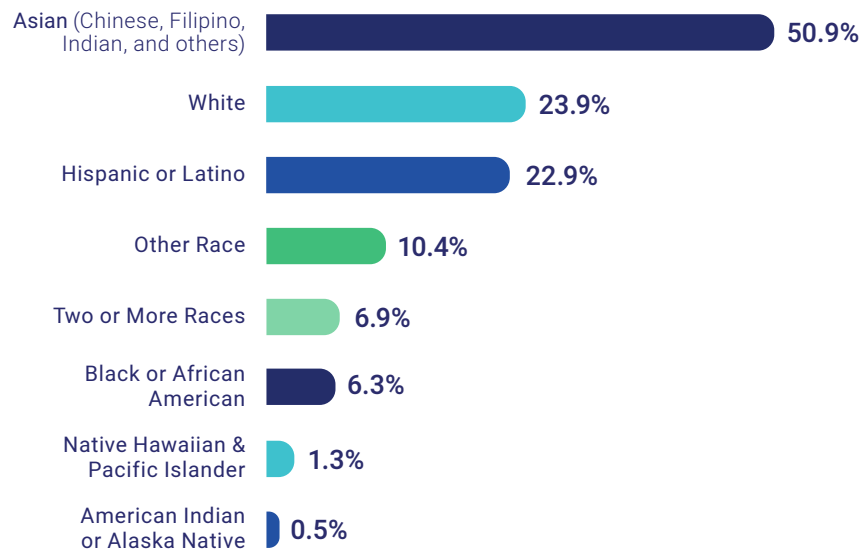


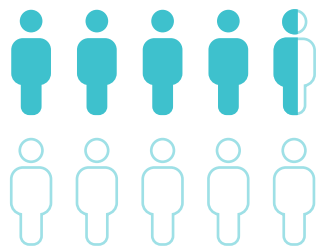
QUICK FACTS - 2017

DEMOGRAPHICS

JOBS

Union City had about **24,000** jobs in 2014

Jobs should grow by roughly **8,350** by 2040

HOUSING

53% of Union City's developed land is housing, which means **over half of Union City's developed land is residential.**

Most of the remaining housing sites are identified for **high-density housing**, which is more affordable.



CITY STAFF

Union City has **232** full-time employees serving 72,000 residents.



Nearly half of those employees work in the **Police Department.**



PARKS

There are **33 parks** in Union City, not including East Bay Regional Parks.



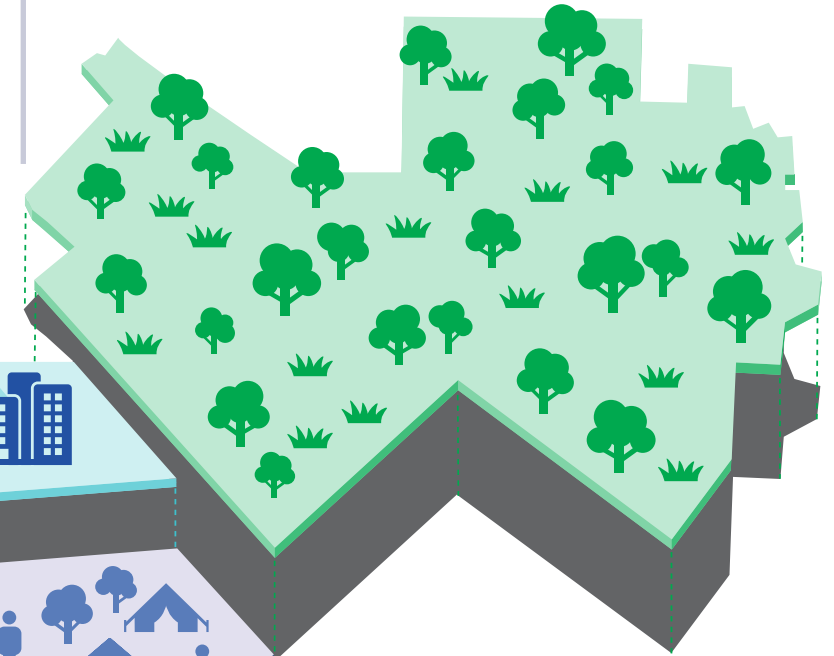
500-700 trees are planted by the City in a year.



500 kids attend community and recreation summer camp in a week

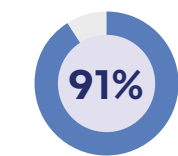
OPEN SPACE

Approximately 7150 acres (58%) of Union City's total land area is **open space.**

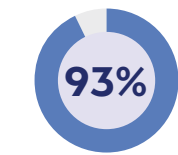


TRAFFIC

We have the **2nd highest** quality of roads in Alameda County.



91% of Union City's workforce works **outside** the city.



93% of Union City's traffic is **"pass through"** (people who neither live nor work in Union City).



2/3 of commuters in the Bay Area still commute alone in their cars.
