



## Alameda County Student Transit Pass Pilot Program

Union City Transit has been partnering with the Alameda County Transportation Commission on a three-year pilot program funded by Measure BB, a countywide transportation sales tax measure. The program makes it easier to travel to and from school, jobs and other activities. The three year pilot program runs through July 2019 with the hopes of creating a basis for a countywide program (funding permitting). Currently 21 schools in Alameda County participate. Two of those schools are Cesar Chavez Middle and James Logan High here in Union City.

The Student Transit Pass is a free Clipper Card that provides unlimited access to Union City Transit and AC Transit bus services and is designed to be valid for the entire year. Students that are eligible for free or reduced priced school meals can receive the free pass.
