

Volunteers wanted to serve on new Community Advisory Committee!

Union City is looking for community members to serve on its Community Advisory Committee (CAC) to provide input on an update to the Decoto Industrial Park Study Area (DIPSA) Specific Plan.

The DIPSA Specific Plan, originally adopted in 1994 and updated in 2006, provided the framework for the coordinated development and reuse of approximately 440 acres of strategically-located land on the east side of the City. See figure below showing the DIPSA boundary. The specific plan addresses a variety of topics including land use, community design, circulation, infrastructure, and economic development. The role of the CAC will be to provide input on updates to the DIPSA Specific Plan. CAC members will be expected to attend up to eight meetings over a two-year period. CAC meetings will take place in the evening on either the first or third Wednesdays of the month. Committee members must either live or be a property owner within the DIPSA boundary or surrounding neighborhoods. Preference will be given to property owners or residents living within the DIPSA boundary. Applicants must be over 18 years old. Applications are due Tuesday, April 30, 2019 at 5:00 pm.
