IMPORTANT VOTER INFORMATION

The California Presidential Primary is now scheduled for TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2020.

In addition, Union City residents also have an opportunity to vote on Measure U, a renewal measure of the public safety parcel tax. Measure U proposes to renew local public safety funding that has been in place for sixteen years. Measure U would also renew this source of local funding for public safety for eight more years.

SAMPLE BALLOT

Measure U: City of Union City PUBLIC SAFETY PARCEL TAX MEASURE

"To maintain 9-1-1 emergency response times, paramedic services, fire prevention/protection, disaster preparedness, neighborhood police patrols, youth violence/gang prevention and safety at public schools shall Union City's measure extending expiring public safety funding be adopted at \$168 per parcel for the most common residential parcel (as described in the ballot pamphlet), providing approximately \$5,000,000 annually for eight years, with annual inflation adjustments, independent citizen oversight and all funds staying local?"
