The City is looking for residents and community members with an interest in bicycling or walking to serve on the City's bicycle and pedestrian advisory committee (BPAC). The BPAC will provide input on the update to the City's Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan update and feedback on specific pedestrian and bicycle projects within the City. The BPAC consists of five members including one representative each from the Planning Commission and the Park and Recreation Commission, two residents from the community at-large, and a representative (either resident or non-resident) from the bicycling community. The BPAC will meet on an as-needed basis. Meetings will occur on the first or third Mondays of the month in the evening. Members shall serve four-year terms and must be 18 years or older.
