



Animal Fanciers Permit Application

The Ordinance limiting the number of adult dogs to two (2) per household became effective January 15, 1987. A Fanciers Permit is required for owners wishing to have more than two (2) dogs. The procedure for acquiring a Fanciers Permit is as follows:

A written application must be filed with the City Manager's office. Submit Application for to City Clerk at CityClerk@unioncity.org or mail to:

There is no fee to submit the permit application. A nominal fee will be required when a permit has been approved. Fees at the time of issuance are as follows (please check one):

Senior (60 or older):	1 year permit only \$22;
Under 60:	1 year - \$122;
	2 years - \$153;
	3 years - \$184

After the application has been received, staff may determine that notification of neighbors within 300 feet of the applicant's property is required. If noticing is required, this will occur within ten (10) working days of receipt of completed application. Neighbors will have ten (10) calendar days to submit written comments, pro or con, to the City Manager. Based on comments received, the City Manager will render a decision within five (5) working days of the end of the comment period.

There is no limit on the number of dogs for which a permit may be requested.

**Renewal of permit is required under Union City Municipal Code 8.20.060.
Renewal Fees are due upon permit expiration.**
