## WHO MAY ENTER

Any student, grades K-12, who lives or attends school in Union City may enter. One entry per student.

## POSTER REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum: 8 1/2 x 11 inches. Maximum: 11 x 17 inches.
- All mediums are accepted: Markers, crayons, water colors, colored pencils, etc. No digital art.
- Poster ideas: Concept and design should be related to environmental conservatism, waste reduction, recycling, or composting.
- Posters created by students must be their own original work.
- A complete Official Entry Form must be attached to each poster artwork entry. Official Entry Forms are available at [UnionCityRecycles.org](http://UnionCityRecycles.org), City Hall, Holly Community Center, and Kennedy Community Center.

## JUDGING

Winners will be selected on their creativity, imagination and the ability to inspire folks to **Make Every Day Earth Day** when reducing waste, recycling, and composting. Winning entries will be announced and featured in the Union City Community and Recreation Services Activity Guide, on the City website, and displayed in the community.
