**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY
AMENDING CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE OF NON-ELECTED OFFICIALS
AND DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY
BY AMENDING APPENDICES B AND C**

WHEREAS, under California Government Code Section 87306(a): Every agency shall amend its Conflict of Interest Code, subject to the provisions of Section 87303, when change is necessitated by changed circumstances, including the creation of new positions which must be designated pursuant to subdivision; and


WHEREAS, amendments or revisions shall be submitted to the code reviewing body within 90 days after the changed circumstances necessitating the amendments have become apparent; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the Conflict of Interest Code Appendices, Designated Positions and Disclosure Categories, because of organizational changes that have occurred since the 2020 biennial review; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Union City, does hereby amend Appendices A and B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, of the Conflict of Interest Code of the non-elected officials and designated employees of the City of Union City.

Consultants

Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation: The City Manager may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a “designated position”, is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements in this section. Such written description of the consultant’s duties should be submitted to and reviewed by the City Manager and, based upon that description, the City Manager should determine in writing the extent of the particular consultant’s disclosure requirements. The City Manager’s determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.

APPENDIX “D”

GENERAL PROVISIONS

When a designated employee is required to disclose investments and sources of income, he or she need only disclose investments in business entities and sources of income which do business in the jurisdiction, plan to do business in the jurisdiction, or have done business in the jurisdiction within the past two years. In addition to other activities, a business entity is considered to be doing business with the jurisdiction if it owns real property within the jurisdiction. When a designated employee is required to disclose interest in real property, he or she need only disclose real property which is located in whole or in part within, or not more than two miles outside of, the boundaries of the jurisdiction, or within two miles of any land owned or used by the local government agency.

Designated employees shall disclose their financial interests pursuant to the appropriate disclosure category as indicated in Appendix “A” and “B”.

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

- Category 1: All investments and sources of income.
- Category 2: All interest in real property
- Category 3: All investments, interests in real property and sources of income subject to the regulatory, permit or licensing authority of the department.
- Category 4: Positions held and investments in business entities and sources of income which engage in land development, construction or the acquisition or sale of real property.
- Category 5: Positions held and investments in business entities and sources of income of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with the City of Union City to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment.
- Category 6: Positions held and investments in business entities and sources of income of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with the designated employee's department to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment.
- Category 7: Positions held and investments in business entities located in the City of Union City proper or in any land or facilities used, owned, or operated by the City of Union City.
- Category 8: Positions held and investments in business entities or investments with natural persons that have contractual obligations or privileges with the City of Union City.
