Shelter-In-Place Order and Teleconference Guidelines

The Alameda County Health Officer issued an order directing residents to shelter in place, due to the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). The order limits activity, travel and business functions to only those that are essential. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, California Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20 on March 17, 2020, governing the convening of public meetings. Pursuant to the Executive Order, all members of the BPAC may participate in meetings without being physically present (via teleconference), and no teleconference locations for the public are required to be provided or noticed in the meeting agenda. The public must be given the opportunity to observe and address the meeting telephonically or otherwise electronically.

Due to the public health emergency, the City of Union City is making several changes related to public meetings to protect the public's health and prevent the disease from spreading locally. Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, including the Alameda County Health Officer and Governor's directives for everyone to shelter in place. The City will not be open to the public. Members of the public can observe and address the meeting using the link or call-in information listed at the top of the agenda. During the public comment portions of the meeting, use the raise your hand button to request to speak.
